#### FYTS Data Review:

- Ever tried cigarettes, cigars, or smokeless tobacco decreased from 32% in 2014 to 24.9% in 2016.
- o Ever tried Electronic Vaping increased from 15.6% in 2014 to 21% in 2016.
- The amount of youth that currently use ENDS increased from 7.5% in 2014 to 10.8% in 2016.
- The amount of youth who currently use cigarettes, cigars, smokeless, hookah, or ENDS is 18.8% compared to 18.6% in 2014.
- o 70.9% are committed to never using cigarettes (compared to 60.8% in 2014)
